

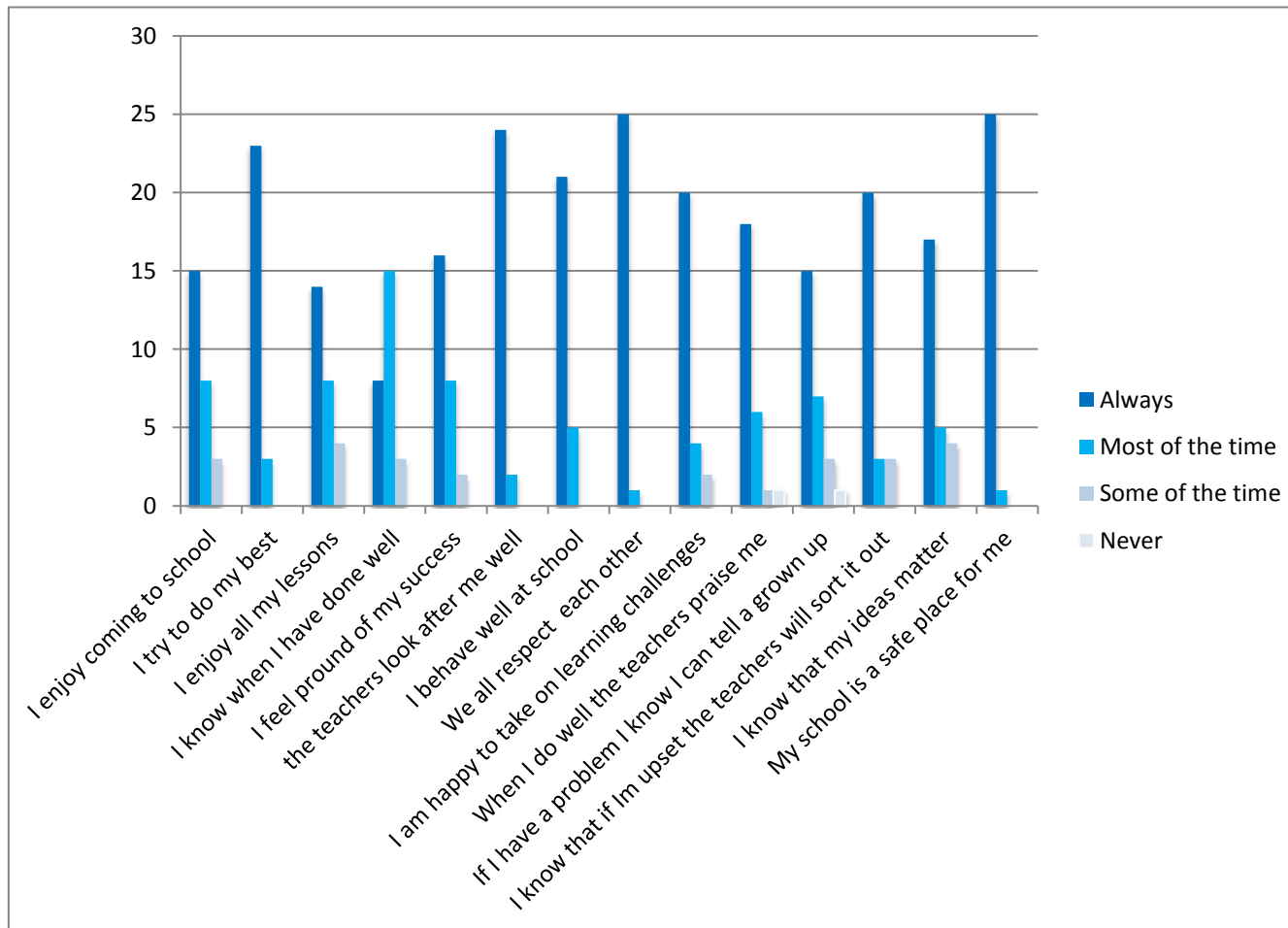
KS 2 PUPIL QUESTIONNAIRE December 2016

Year 3/4

Children in Yr3/4 were clear with their understanding of the words used in the questions. This was especially the case with question 11, they felt the word grown up meant any grown up, not just in school; this is reflected in some responses.

Some explained that they enjoy school, but can't say that they always want to come if there could be something more exciting happening at home.

Only one child didn't respond to always to the school being safe for them, when asked the child said he had fallen over and hurt his knee.



Year 5/6

Children in Year 5/6 were clear in their understanding of the questions, using their use of probability skills as an explanation. They felt that it was difficult to respond 'always' as this was unlikely to really be true; hence the majority opted for 'most of the time' answers. Having said this the highest 'always' answer was for 'school being safe', and like the Yr3/4 the reasons given for 'a most of the time' answer was falls and bumps in the playground.
