

## Swimming End of Year Report 2018/19

Killinghall has adopted a progressive swimming scheme with the Harrogate Hydro. All children from Yr 1 to Yr 6 swim for a term each year. From early swimming in KS1 this progresses to life saving skills, diving and water polo by the time the children reach Upper Key Stage 2.

New children joining the school who have not gone through the developmental programme are 'fast tracked' to ensure skills are developed.
Percentage of Year 6 children who can use a range of strokes effectively	<b>100%</b>	Children are taught through a developmental programme strokes both on their fronts and back.		
Percentage of Year 6 children who can perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situation	<b>100%</b>	Children are taught self-help skills and life saving for others during swim lessons and as part of The Crucial Crew workshops.		
Percentage of other children (yr1 – yr 5) who can swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres.	<b>70% (Yr 1-Yr5)</b>	Children are given opportunities to swim distances appropriate to skills using a preferred stroke. Many exceed the required 25 mts before yr 6.
