Round 1 - English

1. What happened in the film 'Marshmallows'? *A monster from a lake developed a taste for a boy scout's marshmallows.*
2. What is a contraction? *Two word shortened to form 1 word with an apostrophe replacing the missing letters. (e.g. can't won't)*
3. Add a subordinate clause to our class sentence 'The centaur ran'. *Various answers e.g. Because he was late, the centaur ran.*
4. What went wrong in 'Lighthouse'? *The lighthouse bulb broke.*
5. Add an adverbial to our class sentence? *Various answers e.g. The centaur ran under the bridge.*
6. What does the prefix 'mis' mean? *Wrong (You could also say opposite to root word.)*
7. Who wrote 'Still I rise'? *(Maya Angelou)*
8. Add a suffix to the root word 'happy' *Various e.g. happiness, happily*
9. Name 2 compound words. *Various e.g. football, breakfast.*
10. Complete the simile 'As fast as...'
lightning others could apply as long as they make sense.

Round 2 - Maths

1. Round 756 to the nearest 10. *760*
2. $567 + 376 = 943$
3. $400 + 70 + 2 = 472 = 470 + 2$
4. What is the commutative law? *In addition, and subtraction, the numbers you are adding and multiplying can be either way round e.g. $4+3 = 7$, $3+4 = 7$, $6 \times 3 = 18$, $3 \times 6 = 18$.*
5. $6 \times 4 = 24$
6. $9 \times 6 = 54$
7. A regular hexagon has sides of 8cm. What is the perimeter? *48cm*

8. $24 \times 100 = 2400$
9. $7 \times 8 = 56 = 50 + 6 = 8 \times 7$
10. Isaac has 42 pokemon cards. He shares them equally amongst himself and his 6 friends. How many do they each get? **They will get 6 each (remember to include Isaac as well!)**

2. How do we know so much about him? **The Narmer Palette told the story of him unifying upper and lower Egypt.**
3. What is the name of the River that runs through Egypt? **The River Nile.**

5. Whose tomb did Howard Carter discover in 1922? **Tutankhamun**
6. Name 3 Tudor monarchs. **Any 3 from Henry VII, Henry VIII, Edward VI, Lady Jane Grey, Mary I and Elizabeth I.**
7. What was Sir Francis Drake's ship called? **The Golden Hind.**
8. Name 2 ancient Maya cities. Various answers e.g. **Chichen Itza, Copan, Copal.**
9. Write the number 19 in Mayan numbers?



10. Name 2 foods that were special to the ancient Maya. **Cocoa and maize were the most important.**

1. What does import mean? **Buying goods from other countries.**
2. What does export mean? **Selling goods to other countries.**
3. What country did we look at in our global trade lessons? **El-Salvador**
4. What continent is it in? **North America.**
5. What is its capital city? **San Salvador**
6. What are the names of the two polar regions? **Arctic and Antarctica.**
7. How are they different? **Antarctica is a continent. The Arctic is mostly ocean.**
