

Dragon Class Newsletter

Dragon class have settled in well to year 1. We have had a busy first few weeks getting to know each other and learning about year 1. Reading books will be changed on a Monday, Wednesday and Friday unless the children are listened to in school on other days. We do ask that the children read through their book at least twice to help develop their fluency and expression when reading.

In science we have started to learn about our body. We started off by looking at the different body parts we had. We made a life size body and added labels. The children had fun creating labels and counting. They then took their own photos and labelled their own body. Next week we are going to look in more detail about what the different body parts do.



Our topic lessons have started well and we have begun looking at 'buildings tell a story'. We are going to be focusing on castles. The children have been learning about the main purpose of a castle and its different features. Ask your children if they can name the different parts they see.

Our focus in maths for the next few weeks will be place value within 10. Some children are fluently counting to 10 and above we are now working on being able to apply reasoning and problem solving skills within 10 before moving on to larger numbers. We have represented numbers, learnt to write them in different ways and patterns with missing numbers. Next week we are looking at finding one more and one less.
