Yesterday we went on our class trip to Skipton castle. The children have done lots of work building up to this trip about castles from medieval times. We have looked at what rooms they had and how they compare to modern rooms. We will post pictures in our next newsletter about our trip. Please ask your children about the day and what they have learnt.

In science we continued to look at our body and began looking at how we keep our body healthy. The children have been really good at pointing out what they can do to be healthy and what they can avoid to be unhealthy.

Literacy work has been based round a book called The Lonely Beast. The children have really enjoyed using the book to describe the character. We have had some fantastic character descriptions of the Beast. Children are working really hard to use their sounds to spell and write tricky words.

The phonics session for parents is on **Wednesday 2nd October 2019 3:35** in Unicorn Classroom. We will be discussing how we teach children phonics using the Read Write Inc programme. We will show you the picture cards children use in class and the rhymes they use to help with their letter formation. For year 1 parents we will also be explaining the phonics screening check.

Maths work has been excellent in Dragon class. They have worked hard on finding one more and one less. It would be really helpful if you could keep asking children at home one more one less to 10, even on the walk to school. They have begun looking at comparing numbers and using $<>=$ to show which number is the largest or smallest.
